**Sectional Councilman Election:** Previously, the New Jersey Director nominated Councilman LePera for re-election. Councilman LePera's nomination was the only nomination received. Motion by New York, 2<sup>nd</sup> by New Jersey; to re-elect Mike LePera as the Mid-Atlantic Councilman for a two-year term effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008. All in favor, motion passed.

Minutes from the June 3, 2006 Mid-Atlantic Section Annual Business Meeting were distributed. Motion by Pennsylvania, 2<sup>nd</sup> by New Jersey; to accept the minutes. All in favor, motion passed.

**2007 Mid-Atlantic Indoor Tournament**

Councilman LePera gave a report on the March 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>, 2007 Mid-Atlantic Indoor Sectional Tournament. The total number of competitors was 370. Note: There were 288 competitors in 2006. Attendance at the various sites was as follows:

### **2008 Mid-Atlantic Indoor Tournament**

A discussion was held concerning the 2008 Mid-Atlantic Indoor Tournament. Motion by New Jersey, 2<sup>nd</sup> by West Virginia; for a "Better-of-Two NFAA Indoor 300 Round" format for the 2008 tournament. The official score for the Mid-Atlantic Indoor Tournament will be **one** 60 arrow NFAA 300 Round. Competitors will have the option of shooting **one** or **two** 60-arrow rounds.

The 2008 Mid Atlantic Indoor Sectional Tournament will be held on Saturday, March 1<sup>st</sup> & Sunday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2008. Friday, February 29<sup>th</sup> is an optional shooting date for club/range workers.

The pre-registration deadline is Friday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2008. There is **no** late fee. The host clubs/ranges will decide on the number of shooting lines and the times of the shooting lines. New York stated that scoring the last three ends "inside-out X's" was not sufficient to break ties, especially in the Pro Division. New York suggested that "inside-out X's" should be scored for the last four ends. The Directors were unanimously in favor of this suggestion.

Fourteen bids (14) for the 2008 Mid Atlantic Indoor Sectional Tournament were submitted & reviewed. The Directors agreed to accept all fourteen bids. The tournament sites are as follows:

### **2008 Mid-Atlantic Outdoor Sectional Tournament**

A discussion was held concerning the 2008 Mid-Atlantic Outdoor Sectional Tournament. New York submitted a bid for Watkins Glen, New York, but had concerns regarding tournament dates and the rounds of competition. A discussion was held regarding the format of this tournament. Motion by New Jersey, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Maryland; to shoot a 14 target Animal Round on Saturday. Vote: 5 YES (MD, NJ, PA, VA, PRO REP), 1 NO (WV) & 1 ABSTAIN (NY) - motion passed. The tournament format will be a 28 target Field Round & a 14 target Animal Round on Saturday and a 28 target Hunter Round on Sunday.

A discussion was held regarding tournament dates and the impact of any races scheduled at Watkins Glen International racetrack. Motion by New Jersey, 2<sup>nd</sup> by West Virginia; that the 2008 Mid-Atlantic Outdoor Sectional Tournament be held on Saturday, June 28<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, June 29<sup>th</sup>. All in favor, motion passed.

A discussion was held regarding a late fee for this tournament. Motion by Maryland, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Virginia; for no late fee. Vote: 5 NO (NJ, NY, PA, WV, PRO REP) & 2 YES (MD, VA) – motion failed. Motion by New York, 2<sup>nd</sup> by New Jersey; for a \$10 late fee after the pre-registration deadline of Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup>. Vote: 6 YES (NJ, NY, PA, VA, WV, PRO REP) & 1 NO (MD) – motion passed.

**New, Old and Unfinished Business**

Numerous issues and concerns of the Mid-Atlantic Directors were discussed - including but not limited to the following: The status of the NFAA Headquarters in Redlands, California and the status of the 2008 "Stanislawski Open" tournament.

Motion to adjourn at 5:34 PM by New York, 2<sup>nd</sup> by West Virginia - all in favor, motion passed.
