

Triangle Archers General Club Rules 2007

Range will be available when scheduled activities are not in progress between **March and September**.

Range will be closed for the winter after Archery Season begins, the first Saturday in October.

The Practice Area near the Clubhouse will remain open. Pets must be leashed!

All children under the age of 18 **MUST** be supervised by an adult while archery shooting, competition or practice is occurring. Children carrying Bows and Arrows **MUST** be accompanied by adults at all times.

Range is open during the daylight hours ONLY and all vehicles must be parked in the parking area near the clubhouse. No vehicles allowed on the range except for maintenance or during a Work Day.

No guns, hunting or broadheads allowed on the property, unless a special event is scheduled. **Fall Bowhunting and broadhead tuning is controlled by Jim Overfelt, President.**

Safety first, we have insurance and have never used it, let's don't start now! Think and look before shooting.

Guests may NOT be invited by non-members. Members are allowed to invite guests, hopefully as potential members. Guests must be supervised by the member at all times while on club property.

Identification card will be issued and must be carried on the range.

The entrance gate must be locked at all times except when a tournament is in progress.

If in doubt about a rule don't assume anything, contact the Executive Officers. Phone numbers at bottom of page.

Do Not remove or move a target. Do NOT bring a target to the range. This is the Range Captains job.

Targets are not to be taken home, even well used ones!

Take your trash home. It is nice to bring food to the range to enjoy but please take your trash home.

All rules and By-Laws and Policies must be followed as prescribed by Triangle Bowhunters Incorporated, Triangle Archers and the policies of the Board of Directors of Triangle Bowhunters Inc. Policies and Rules may be changed at any time and no notice is required. Infractions of any rules or policies will be dealt with by the BOD. Anyone expelled will NOT be given a refund.
