

# **Virginia Field Archery Association**

Annual Meeting – August 9, 2008

The meeting was held at the meeting room of the Izaak Walton Park in Madison Heights, Virginia at 4:00 PM.

Officers and Directors present were CD Miller, Ricky Williams, and Jim Quarles.

There were nine members in attendance.

## **Membership Report – Jim Quarles**

Membership now stands at 202 as of July 31, 2008, which is up from about 180 for several previous years.

The members survey as performed by Jim French has a response of seventeen. This is less than we had hope for, but the survey remains open and members are invited to respond at any time.

## **Treasurers Report – CD Miller**

Current funds are \$5513.47. The current dues structure is adequate.

The VFAA has adequate funds to finance the inventory of the championship plaques and to pass the cost through to the hosts without profit to the VFAA.

## **Tournament Report – Jim Quarles**

Indoor – total shooters = 76; A&A = 23; Wythe = 27; Prince William = 26.

Mid Atlantic Virginia Locations – total shooters = 67; total all states = 358.  
A&A = 27; Wythe = 20; Prince William = 20.

VBA Indoor = 49 NFAA members; total = 113. This means that VBA had 64 shooters who are local in state members only.

Mid Atlantic outdoor in Watkins Glen = 148.

Spring Field Championship = 13.

Animal Championship = 29.

State Outdoor Championship = 30.

## **NFAA Report – Jim Quarles**

The NFAA sale of the property in Redlands California has now been completed with a realization of about \$800,000 after commissions.

The new building is under construction with the shell structure complete and utilities and indoor build-out underway. The building is 23,000 square feet, which includes NFAA offices, meeting room, classrooms, indoor range, and museum space.

NFAA owns 40.5 acres of land that the building, two field ranges, and one FITA range are located on. There is other land currently available for NFAA use that has three field ranges.

The arrow size restriction is currently dead until the 2009 NFAA board of directors meeting.

Attendance at the Mid Atlantic tournaments for 2008 was previously reported as 358 for indoor and 148 for outdoor.

The 2009 Mid Atlantic Indoor will be at 15 sites, 4 in Virginia.

- Prince William, HuntShak, Walton Park, and Wythe.
- March 6, 7, and 8.
- NFAA Indoor 300 Round, Shoot 1 or 2, turn in 1 score, tie breaker 6 ends I/O.

The 2009 Mid Atlantic Outdoor will be at Cape May, NJ.

- June 6 and 7.
- First day 28 hunter, 14 animal. Second day 28 field. Start 0830 each day.
- Please register by May 25, however there are no late registration fees.

The 2009 NFAA national championship will be in Mechanicsburg, PA.

- Dates are July 22 – July 26. Wednesday to Sunday 5/3 format.
- Wednesday and Saturday – field rounds
- Thursday and Sunday - hunter rounds
- Friday - animal round
- Shoot all five days or any one field, one hunter, and the animal. Your highest or only field and hunter rounds are counted.

Las Vegas tournament is February 6, 7, and 8.

National Indoor Championship is March 14, 15 in Louisville, KY.
